Primary school PE and school sport: new funding 2014/15

Background

1. In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision.
2. Funding will be allocated to all maintained and state-funded schools with primary phase pupils, including: primary, middle, special and non-maintained special schools, academies and pupil referral units from 1 September 2013. A typical infant school will receive about £8,135 annually in the academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15.
3. Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

How will we be spending the PE and Sport funding this year and who will benefit?

The school has completed an audit of PE, school sport and physical activity to inform how we can further improve our provision. Feedback from the audit and from our staff have informed our decision to use the PE funding for the following:

Action	Success Criteria
Provision of spare school PE kits.	All year groups to have spare PE and Games kits for those to use to be retained in school. School to achieve 100% participation. Approximate cost £100
Premier Sport coach to provide expertise in teaching PE and sport.	Premier Sport coach to work regularly with all KS1 children. Teachers to work alongside the coach to up skill themselves and focus in on the assessment of the children. Approximate cost £2500 (based on last year's costs).
Extend resources to promote safety and success.	Purchase of appropriately sized benches which are more lightweight and suitable for infant use.
The provision of balance bikes for Reception Class.	Reception Class to build on their balance bike training by having access to a set of balance bikes. Approximate cost £500
Increase inter-schools sports opportunities.	Pay for transportation of children to a variety of sports events and festivals. 100% KS1 participation in inter-school festivals. Approximate cost £600
Investment in involvement with Chesterfield SSP.	Chesterfield SSP will support the school to provide more opportunities to involve our children in sport and the importance of a healthy lifestyle. See the following for a more detailed breakdown of what this means for our school. Cost £1850
Training and cover for PE subject leader.	Subject leader to attend PE related courses and supply to be covered from funding. Approximate cost £400.
Contribution to Trim Trail	Trim Trail to be installed. £2549 raised by PTFA Cost £1000.
