Allocation

For the financial year 2014 – 2015 our school has been allocated **£107,900**

The table below shows how we intend to allocate this funding:-

The data shows that:

- Disadvantaged pupils are attaining better than other pupils at 2c+ in all core areas and in reading and maths at 2b+ and in maths at level 3+
- Analysis of data shows that the attainment gap is closing.
